In a recent study performed by the **PEAR Institute** our students reported that, since starting with ASB:

- 85% of our students have shown significant gains in Academic Motivation, Perseverance, and Learning Interest
- 83% of students reported a positive change in their relationships with adults


supporters, our students are thriving!
