ASB recently wrapped up our annual Arise! concert with two sold-out shows! More than 160 performers, ages 8 to 18, brought 9 original dance pieces to life, choreographed by 12 incredible artists. Students, alumni, staff, and parent volunteers worked together behind the scenes to make it all happen. El Alebrije 2024

El Alebrije is our annual winter dance performance, a Mexican-American reimagining of The Nutcracker Ballet. This year's production showcased over 150 A Step Beyond students, ages 8 to 18, along with our student tech crew and guest performances from parents and volunteers. The event also featured original artwork from students in grades 3–12, inspired by their hopes and dreams for themselves, their community, and the world.

Family Service Events

Family Services hosted several events for ASB youth and families throughout the school year, including a movie night featuring Wicked and a well-attended Teen Positive Parenting workshop led by Jewish Family Service. Additionally, 49 middle and high school students participated in a Youth Healthy Relationships workshop facilitated by Breaking Down Barriers. At the Arise! Concert, students proudly exhibited over 80 diverse artworks—from oil pastels and collages to dioramas—in a vibrant gallery display.

Audition Day

In September 2024, ASB held its annual Audition Day, where youth from across Escondido and San Marcos learned and performed a dance in hopes of joining our ten-year program. ASB offered 70 scholarships, with 62 students enrolling. Highlights included our oldest students leading auditions and strong support from staff, parents, and volunteers.

Our third class of seniors at A Step Beyond graduate from high school this month and 100% are moving on to the college and career programs of their choice this fall! We will celebrate their achievements with a beautiful graduation ceremony on June 13th and are excited for all that lies ahead. COLLEGE TOURS, CAREEER EDUCATION & WORKSHOPS

As part of ASB's College & Career Readiness Initiative, students took part in a series of college tours to build early awareness of higher education. Highlights included visits to Cal State San Marcos (6th grade), San Diego State (7th), the University of San Diego (8th), and Palomar College (9th), giving students a firsthand look at college life. In addition to college exposure, ASB offers career readiness programming across all grade levels. Students in grades 3-6 participate in six career simulation lessons annually, introducing a wide range of professions through engaging, age-appropriate activities. Middle and high school youth deepen this exploration through eight intensive 10-week career simulation labs—from structural engineering to alternative energy—providing hands-on, project-based learning experiences that help students discover their interests and career pathways. Family engagement also supports this initiative, with over 90 parents participating in academic workshops this past spring on adolescent development, academic planning, and dual enrollment.

CEO & Board Chair Nominations

Our Chief Executive Officer, James Wright, was selected as a nominee for the 2025 CEO of the Year award by the San Diego Business Journal. Dr. José Villarreal, ASB Board Chair, was also recognized with a nomination for the Nonprofit Board Leader of Influence award. A special feature on A Step Beyond is included in the magazine. ASB's Winter Celebration was a joyful, community-filled evening, complete with dancing, games, cookie decorating, and face painting. 
